PLANNING FOR THE WHOLE YEAR

COUNTING, SORTING, REFLECTING



THESE SNOWY WINTER DAYS MAKE US WANT TO DREAM OF DAYS IN THE SUN WITH OUR HANDS IN THE DIRT SO WHEN THOSE BEAUTIFUL COLOURFUL SEED CATALOGUES ARRIVE IN YOUR MAILBOX IT'S VERY EASY TO GET EXCITED AND START DREAMING OF ALL THE YUMMY, PRETTY THINGS WE'RE GOING TO **GROW IN OUR GARDENS AND FLOWER BEDS. I MUST** ADMIT I DO INDULGE IN FLIPPING THROUGH AND **CIRCLING SOME INTRIGUING ITEMS BEFORE I REEL** MYSELF IN AND MAKE A PLAN.

HERE ARE SOME OF THE THINGS I CONSIDER AND DO BEFORE ORDERING MY SEEDS FOR THE SEASON ***WHAT IS LEFT IN OUR FOOD STORAGE? **CANNING SHELVES? FREEZERS?*****

I LIKE TO TAKE THIS TIME TO DO SOME ORGANISING AND STOCK TAKING OF OUR STORAGE SPACES. PULL **OUT ALL THE EMPTY JARS FROM THE SHELVES AND** TAKE INVENTORY FOR THE CANNING SEASON. CHECK DATES ON THE CANNED GOODS ON THE SHELVES AND TOSS (AKA FEED TO CHICKENS AND COMPOST) ANYTHING OLDER THAN 2 YEARS. I'LL POLL THE FAMILY AS WELL AT THIS TIME TO SEE WHAT SHOULD BE REPEATED OR TAKEN OFF THE MENU. PICKLES ARE ALWAYS A FAVOURITE AS ARE GREEN BEANS, PEACHES, PEARS AND CHERRIES. I FIND SOMETIMES THAT THE CANNING GETS FORGOTTEN IN THE **BASEMENT AND I AM ENDEAVOURING TO BRING** ITEMS UP TO THE KITCHEN ON A REGULAR BASIS TO MORE EASILY INCLUDE THEM IN OUR DIET.S LIKEWISE WITH THE FREEZER. I LIKE TO DIG TO THE BOTTOM.. THAW OUT THE MYSTERY BAGS. A COUPLE AT A TIME, MAKE JAM, SOUP OR BAKING OR MAYBE JUST COMPOST. LOOK AT WHAT FROZE WELL AND WHAT WE MAY WANT TO PROCESS DIFFERENTLY IN THE FUTURE.. AS FREEZERS TAKE ELECTRICITY, IF I **CAN REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF FREEZER SPACE USED** BY FOOD THAT COULD BE DEHYDRATED OR CANNED

BY NOW MOST SQUASH, ROOT VEGGIES, ONIONS AND GARLIC WE HAVE STORED HAVE BEEN **CONSUMED AND IF WE DO HAVE SOME LEFT ITS TIME** TO THINK ABOUT PROCESSING THEM INTO OTHER FORMS AND STORING THEM.

THEN THAT IS A BENEFIT.

WHICH CROPS PRODUCED WELL AND WHICH STRUGGLED? AND WHY?

A LOOK BACK AT HOW THE GARDEN FARED. I TAKE THE TIME TO LOOK AT THE VARIETIES OF VEGETABLES I CHOSE TO PLANT AND WHETHER THEY MET THE **NEEDS AND TASTES OF OUR FAMILY. FOR INSTANCE I** PLANTED TWO VARIETIES OF PICKLING CUCUMBERS AND TRULY PREFERRED ONE OVER THE OTHER. WE HAVE A FEW RELIABLE STANDARDS THAT WE PLANT **EACH YEAR BUT I LIKE TO TRY SOME NEW THINGS** EACH YEAR AND TEND TO ADD ONE OR TWO OF THESE TO OUR PLAN IN FOLLOWING YEARS. IT IS GOOD TO CHANGE UP VARIETES AS THERE ARE NEW ONES AVAILABLE AND SOMETIMES YOU CAN TRICK THE BUGS WITH NEW TASTES AND THEY WILL BE A LITTLE LESS TROUBLESOME WITH SOME ROTATION. ***WHAT WILL WE GROW FOR FUN THIS

YEAR??***

EACH YEAR WE CHOSE A FEW UNIQUE PLANTS, A COUPLE PRACTICAL AND A COUPLE JUST FOR FUN, BEAUTY OR CREATIVITY. ITS GOOD TO EXPERIMENT AND TRY NEW THINGS. BUT I HAVE LEARNED BY **ERROR TO DO MY RESEARCH AND BE SURE I AM PUTTING MY "NEW" PLANTS IN THE RIGHT** LOCATION.

***WHERE WILL WE BE GROWING THIS YEAR?

I DO BELIEVE THAT CROP ROTATION IS NECESSARY TO ENSURE HEALTHY SOIL AND PEST MANAGEMENT. IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP A RECORD OF SOME SORT OF THE LAYOUT OF YOUR GARDEN YEAR TO YEAR. I TEND TO DO THIS WITH PICTURES ON MY PHONE TO REFERENCE IS EASY. I AM ALSO IN A STATE OF **EXPANSION OF THE GARDEN AS I HOPE TO DO SOME** GROWING FOR MARKETS AND OTHER MEANS. NOW ITS TIME TO MAKE A PLAN AND ORDER THOSE SEEDS!!

I TEND TO ORDER FROM AT LEAST 3 DIFFERING SEED **COMPANIES AND ALSO FREQUENT MY LOCAL SEED SAVERS TO EXCHANGE SEEDS AND GAIN** KNOWLEDGE. WE DO SAVE SEEDS FROM A LOT OF **OUR PLANTS BUT DO NOT ALWAYS HAVE AS MANY** AS WE NEED.
